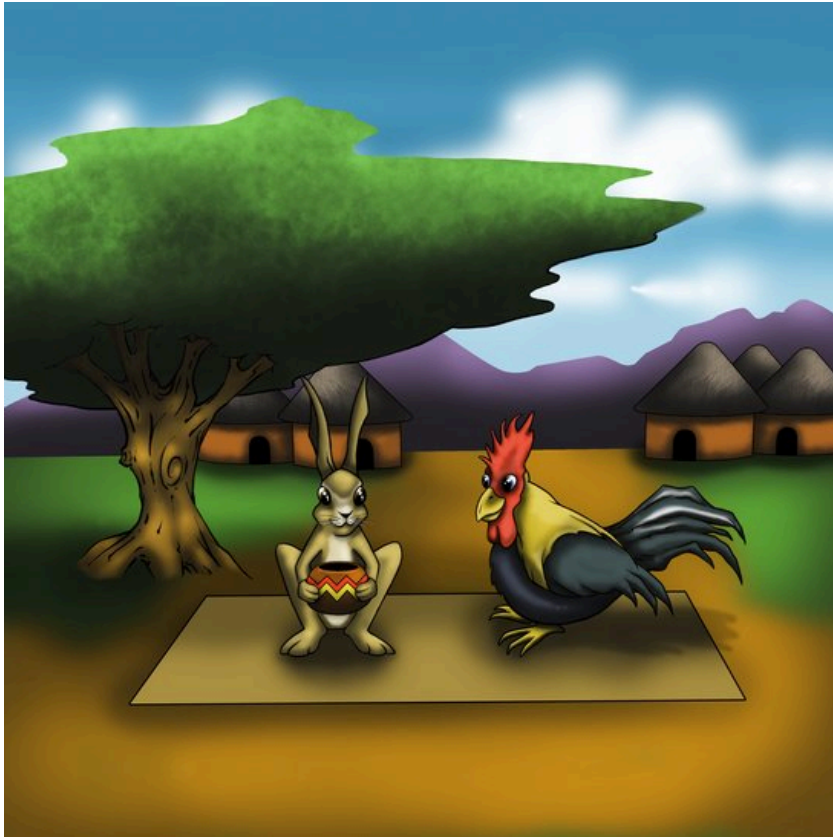


Rooster and Hare

Hare was not able to sleep the whole night.



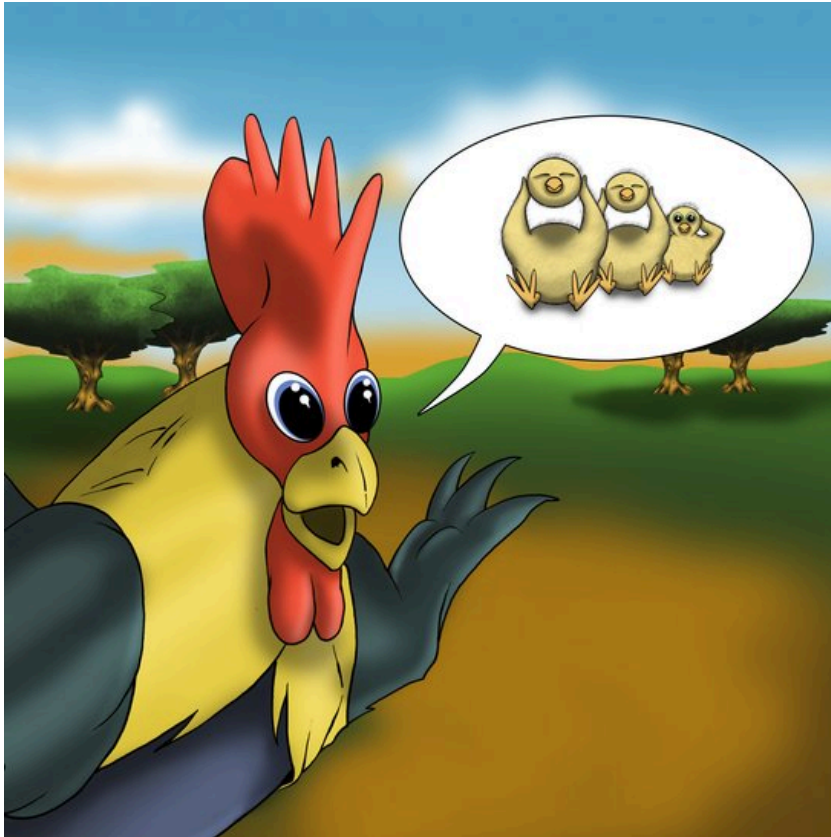
In the morning,
