



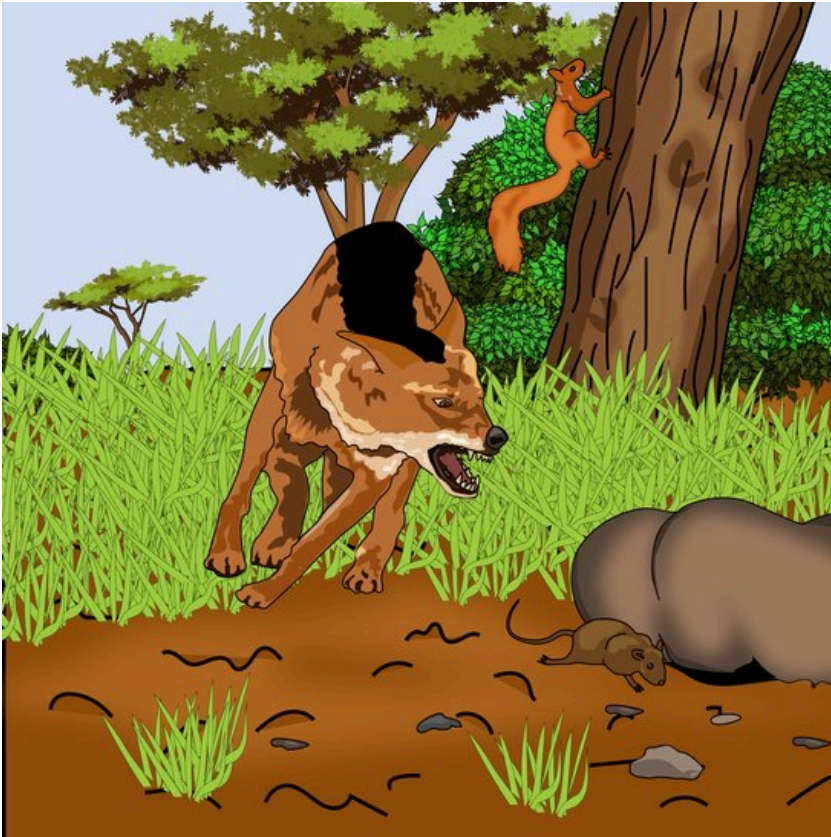
Ungrateful Jackal

Hungry Jackal was hunting.



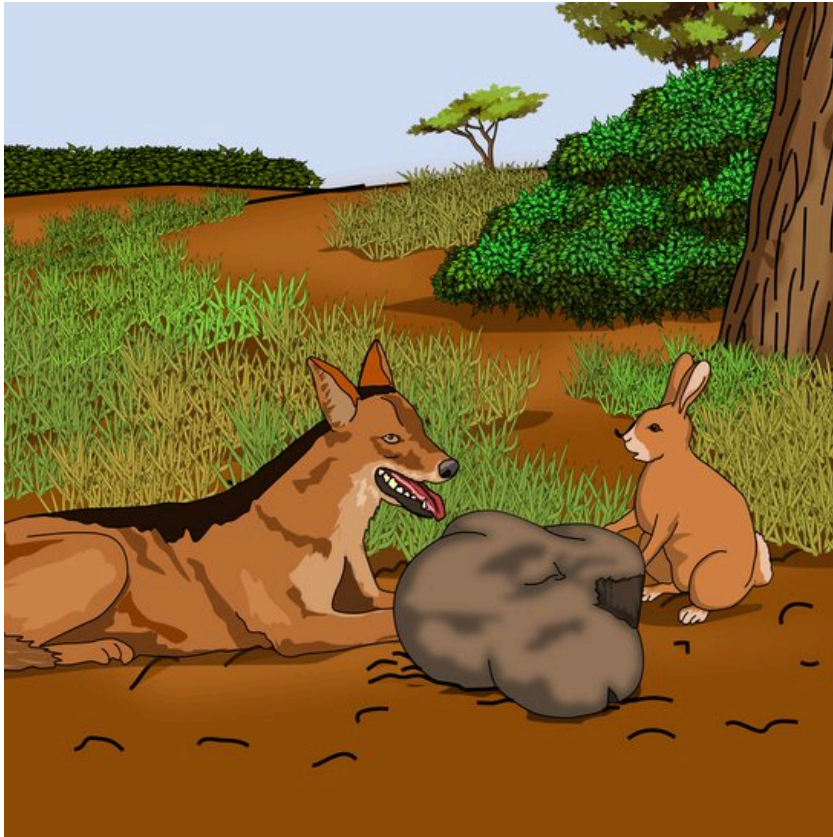
He chased a

paw.



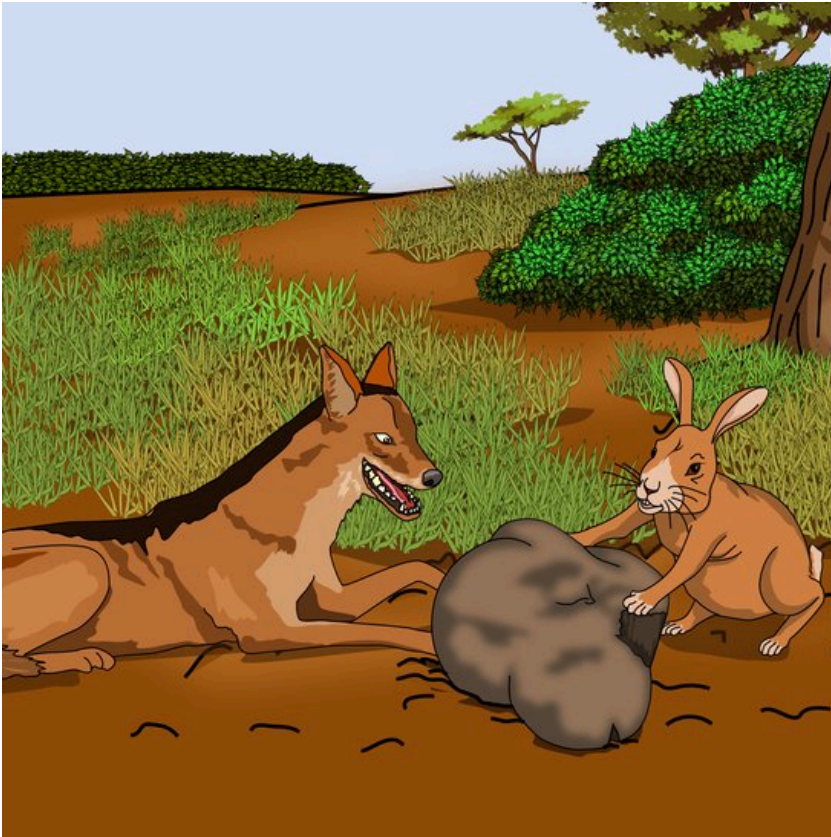
Rabbit heard Jackal calling.

his reward.

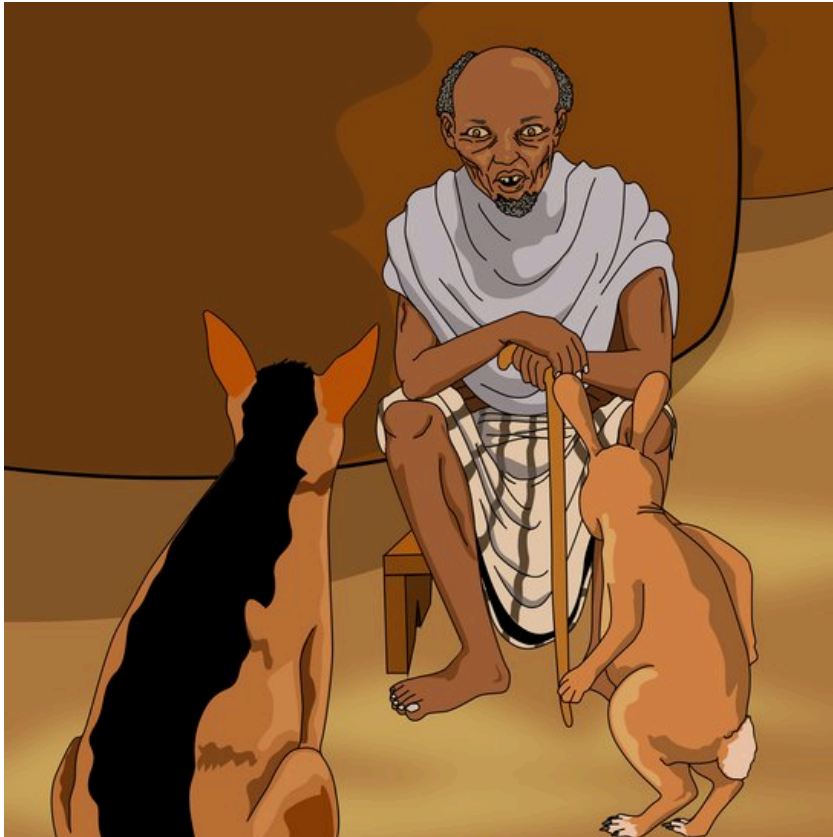
Jackal threatened
