



Jaaka the fisherman

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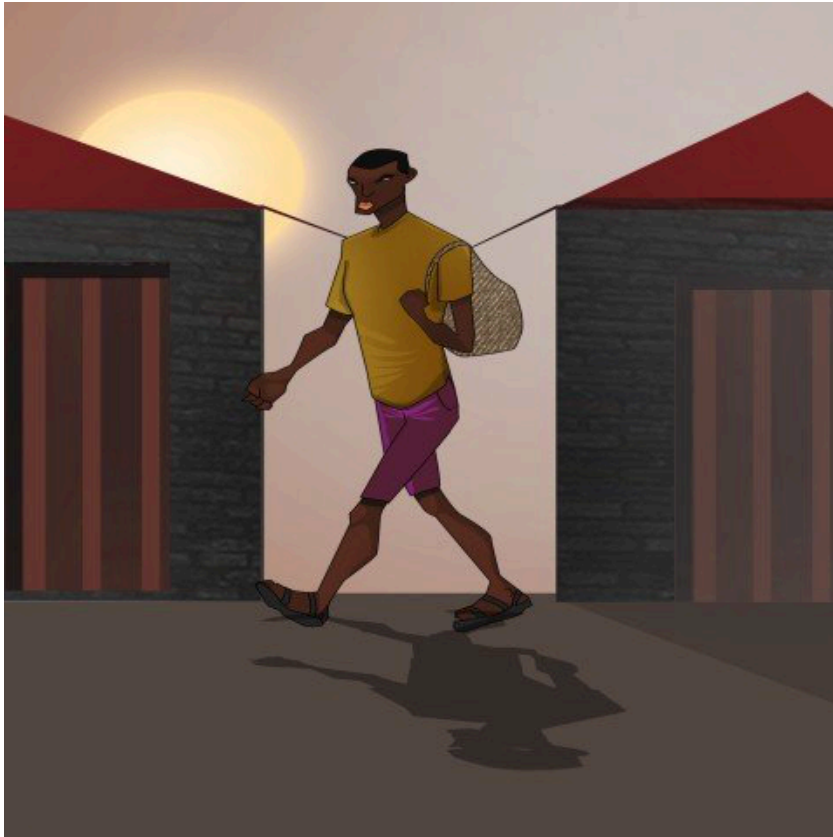
This is Jaaka the fisherman from Naminya.
