great!



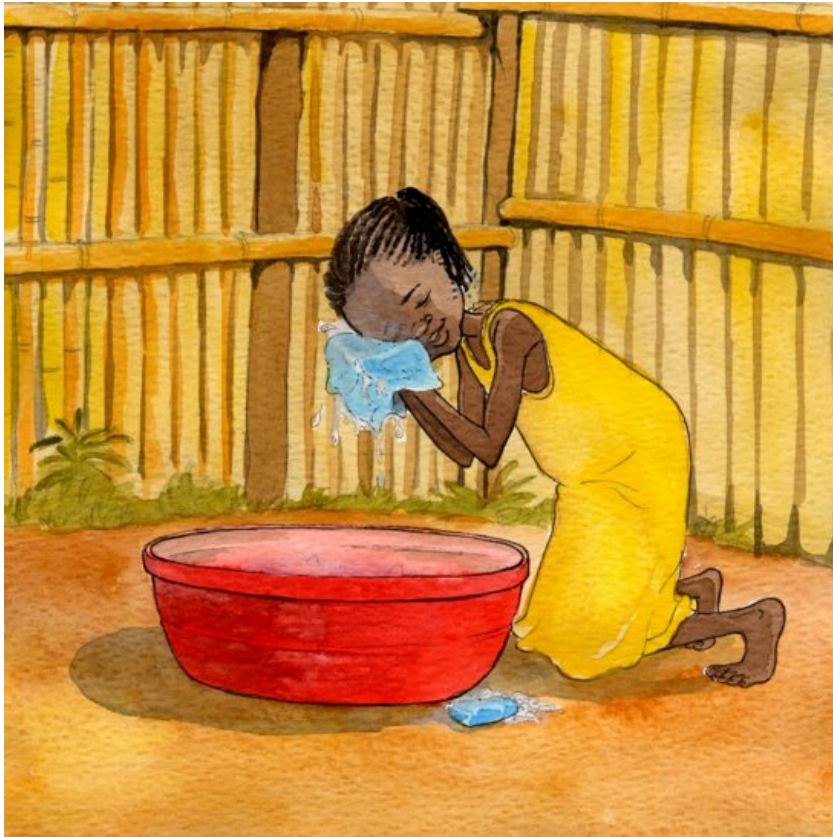
I am the one who

I wash myself every day, I don't need any help.

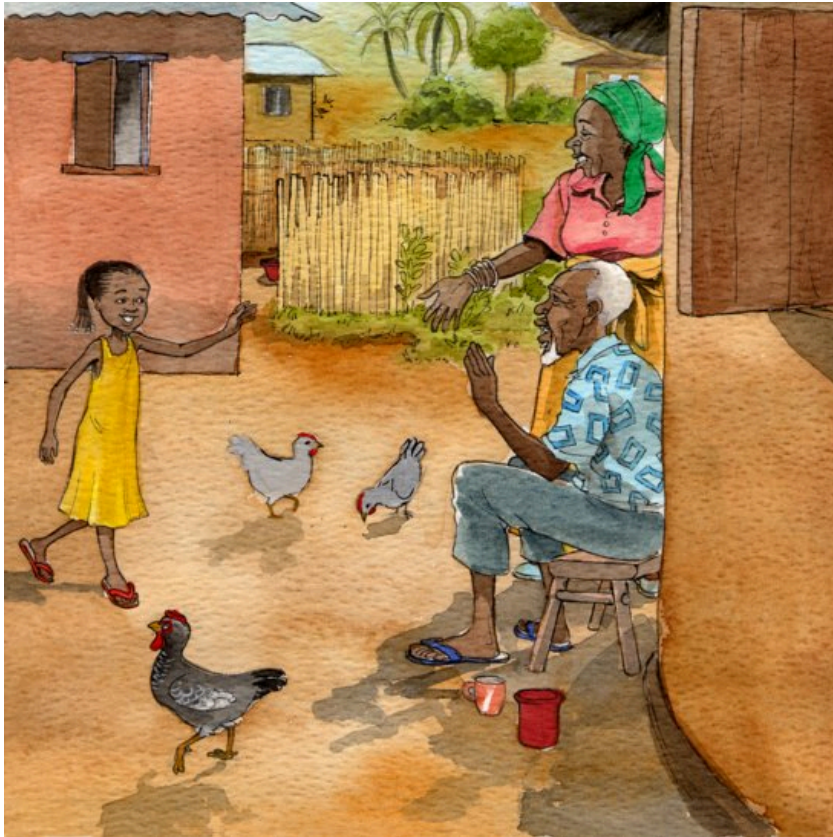


I don't mind cold water, or the blue soap that washes clothes.

day.

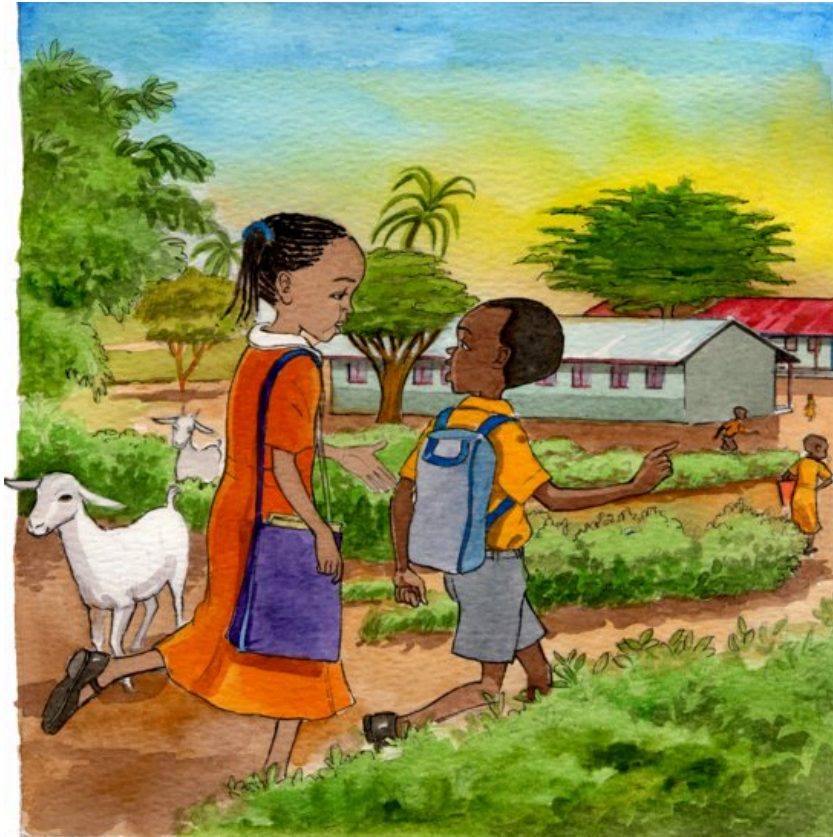


Then I dress
myself.

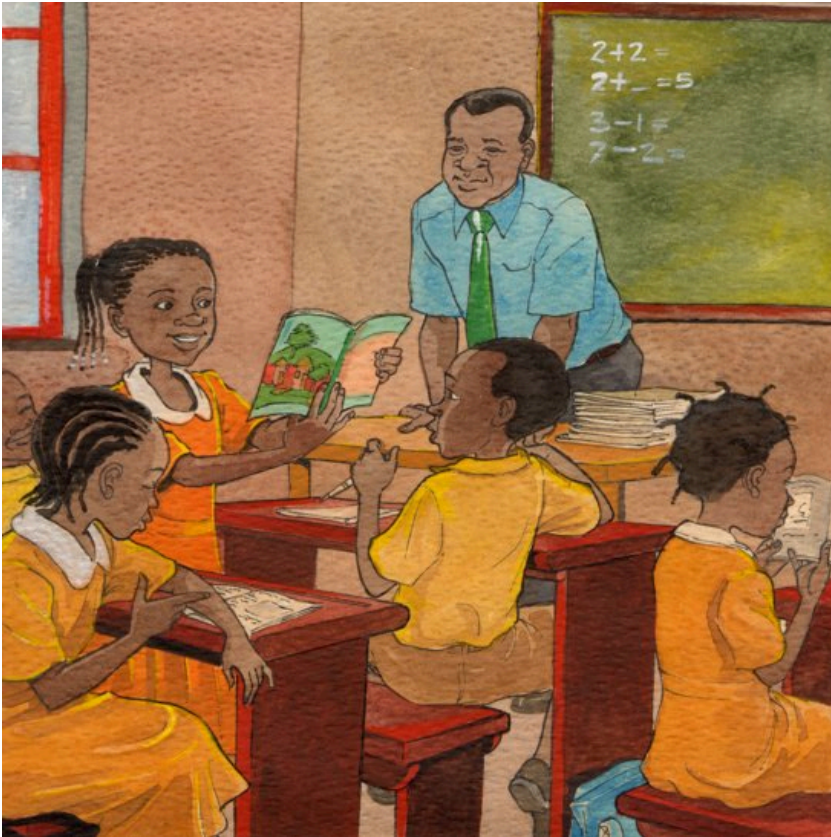
"I'm big now, Ma," I
